WEARING LOVE

The angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God."

—Luke 1:30 NRSV

IMAGINE VELVETY DARKNESS, sprinkled with thousands of bright stars...the kind of night sky you can only see on a dark country road far away from city lights. If you've ever experienced such an encounter, you might remember feeling deep awe as you drank in the beauty.

Now imagine that starry sky interrupted with one of the brightest stars you've ever seen, with the light from that magnificent star extending in all directions through the darkness.... It is not just a star, but a pathfinder... a compass.

That brilliant compass is what the magi followed – a star that pointed them in the direction of Bethlehem marking the spot where the newborn Christ Child lay.

Have you ever hoped for a beacon like that star? Have you ever wished for a sign from God that left no doubt what you were to do next in your life?

Sometimes we receive spotlights of clarity, but most often wisdom arrives in small glimmers of insight parsed out after much prayer and discernment. As they prepared for the birth of Jesus, both Mary (Luke 1:30) and Joseph (Matt. 1:20) were given the message, "Do not be afraid." What an affirming message during a time of change! Both Mary and Joseph were faithful to that message they received, moving with God through their fear and embracing the new journey upon which God had sent them.

Meister Eckhart wrote, "We are all meant to be mothers of God. For God is always needing to be born." There will always be ways that God is bringing new life into our world. God longs for us to let go of our fear, listen to God's guidance, and be part of what is happening. Like the magi, we follow the star — or the fragments of insight that we are sent — until we can see God's vision.

During Advent and beyond, I encourage you to engage in some daily practices: 5-10 minutes of spiritual reading and prayer, building one new friendship/relationship, and putting your faith into action daily.



PUMPKINS FOR PEACE

WEST SIDE'S LAWN was filled with pumpkins in October! The proceeds from pumpkins and gourds sold were donated to aid Ukrainian refugees. West Siders and community friends unloaded trucks, made artwork, worked at the cash registers, and spent countless hours on financial and communication details.

West Side Christian Church hosted the pumpkin patch in partnership with Apostolic Assembly of Faith in Jesus Christ, The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, Flint Hills Harmony Chorus, Midtown Community Services, Potwin Presbyterian Church, TopCity Supports Ukraine, and Topeka Center for Peace and Justice.



The church's \$2,000 donations and profits were donated to support local refugees through TopCity Supports Ukraine and to support international refugees through Week of Compassion, a relief fund of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) in the United States and Canada.

After the event, West Side congregants made Thanksgiving cards and delivered the cards and some pumpkins to local Ukrainian refugees.




